# Madrisa Trail Klosters 2023: the alpine adventure for all trail running lovers

Spectacular trails in front of magnificent natural scenery: The Madrisa Trail Klosters, which takes place on August 19, 2023 in the Swiss canton of Graubünden, promises trail running in its purest form. The T54 Trail adds up to over 4,000 meters of elevation gain over 54 kilometers, with about 90% trail content, making it a feast for all fans of alpine trail running. Slightly less demanding, but no less attractive: the T24 Trail offers a beautiful panoramic trail above the valley floor of Klosters. The ideal introduction to the world of trail running - and for all those who like it fast.



The Madrisa Trail Klosters will take place for the fourth time, in 2023. The organizer is the existing association runningsports.ch from Klosters, which has taken care of the spectacular trails for the last 3 years.

2023 welcomes the event agency PLAN B as a strong organization partner. PLAN B organizes (among others) the Zugspitz Ultratrail and the Transalpine Run.
